* Be at least 21 years old * Have a stable home and income * Be willing to be fingerprinted and have a criminal records check * Maintain a drug free environment * Complete all required training and be licensed by the state of NC * One or two parent households * Parents who work or stay home * Those who have raised children and those who have not.
