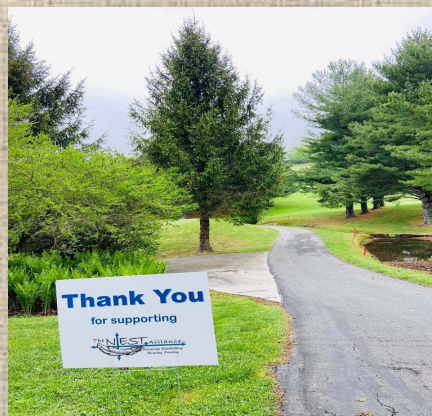

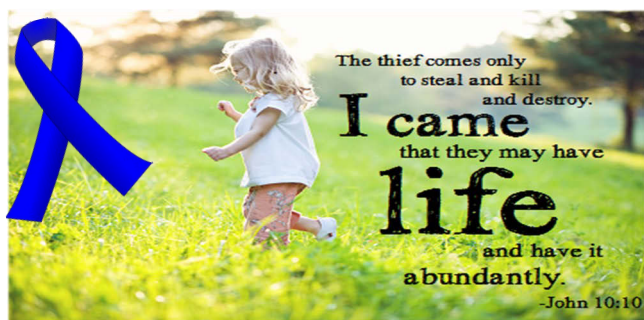

APRIL IS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH



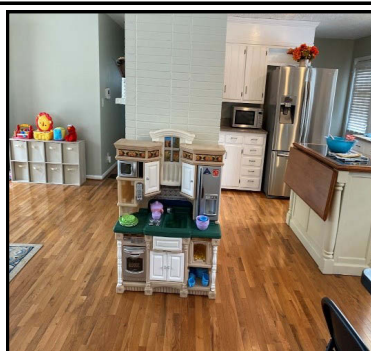
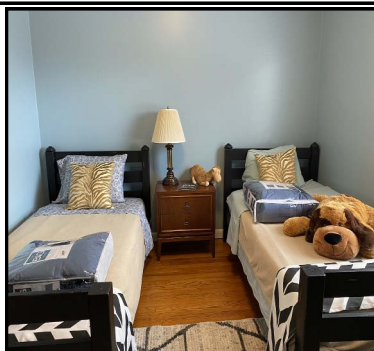
May is National Foster Care Month

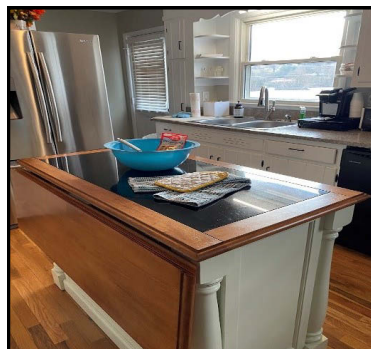
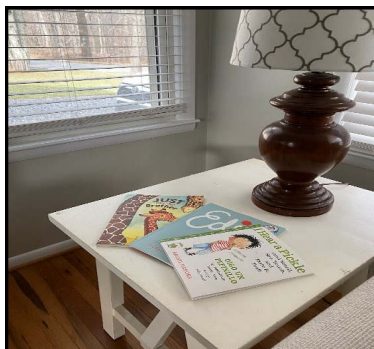
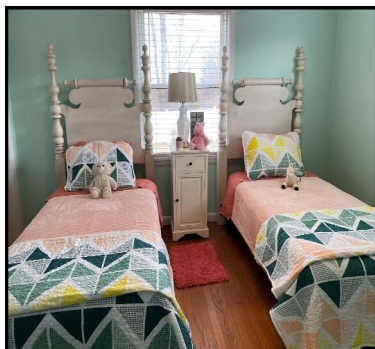
Missions: NEST Kids, NEST Net, Roots and Wings Children's Homes
