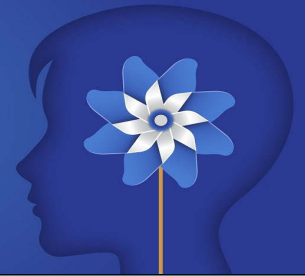

Child Abuse, Neglect, Poverty and the Foster Care System

Whenever possible, The NEST Alliance supports families before it becomes necessary for foster care involvement to take place. We also work to support a child or youth when they must enter the foster care system through offering the facilities and resources of The NEST Center and through outreach efforts in all 3 missions of our organization.

"In some regions of the US, spikes in children entering foster care appear to be connected with increased parental drug use. Foster care involvement becomes necessary and is also closely tied to poverty. Child abuse and neglect rates for children in families of low socioeconomic status are five times higher than families of higher socioeconomic status. This is one of the reasons that supporting biological families before foster care is necessary is so essential."
